



BedZED Pavilion is a community facility for the Hackbridge area, located on the A237 between Mitcham Junction and Hackbridge rail stations. It was built by a partnership between Sutton Council and the Peabody Trust as part of the innovative and environmentally friendly BedZED development of housing and workspace completed in 2002. It consists of:

- Reception / social area with a small beverage servery area
- Community room / seminar space at mezzanine level for 60 people
- Toilets and changing rooms, including showers
- Outdoor adjoining grassed area 90m x 45m

Activities at the Pavilion:

The Pavilion is used for regular sessions including:

- Yoga, Pilates, Tai Chi and Aerobics for adults,
- family activities for children and their parents/carers,
- drama and street dance for young people, and the
- VegZED cooperative food ordering scheme and farmers' market.

Future planning includes improvements to the catering facilities and developing a community cafe.

Venue hires

The BedZED Pavilion is available for hire for day, evening and weekend seminars or events. It can comfortably hold 60 people in theatre layout or around tables, or 12-20 for activity classes.

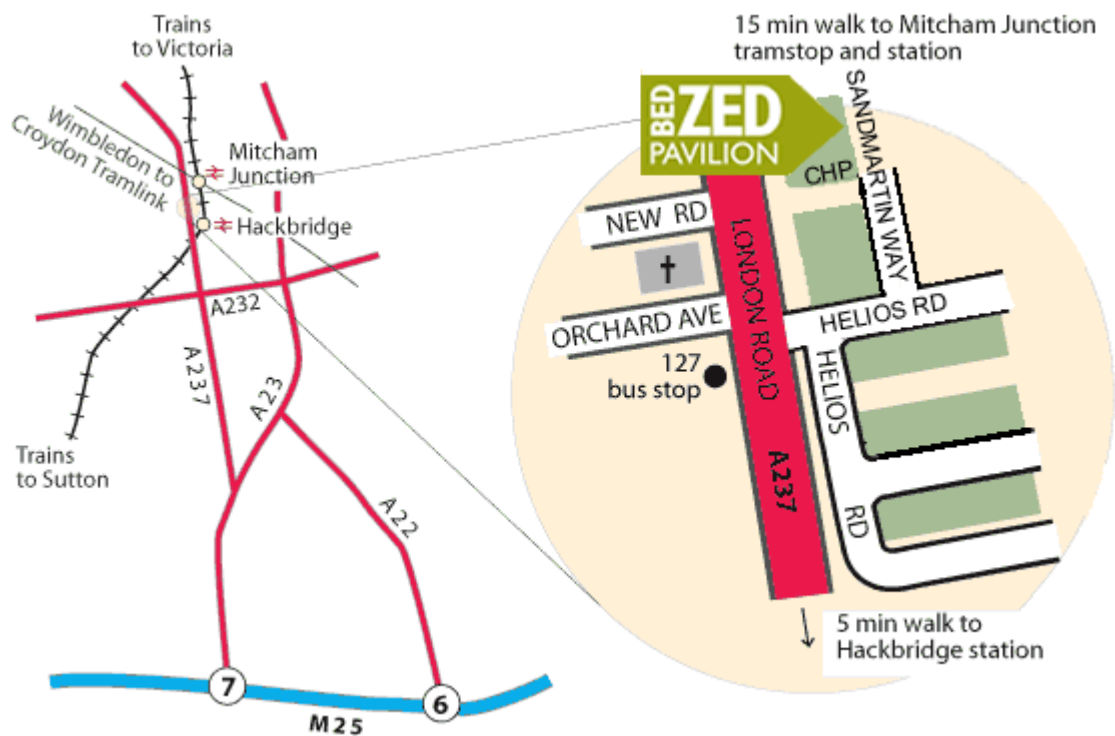

Location and Directions to BedZED:



From London Road: BedZED is opposite All Saints Church. Turn into Helios Road, then left into Sandmartin Way and follow the pavement to the end. The Pavilion is on your left.

By rail: Direct trains to Hackbridge station from Victoria (20 mins) or Kings Cross Thameslink (35 mins). Turn right out of station. BedZED is 5 minutes walk north along London Road (A237).

By bus: No. 127 from Purley to Tooting (stops on either side of London road near BedZED), No. 151 from Sutton to Wallington (stops near Hackbridge Station at Hackbridge Rd. and London Rd., then walk five minutes north on London Rd.)

By underground/bus: From Morden Station of Northern Line Underground, No. 80 bus, 12 minute ride to Culvers Close terminus, then five minute walk east to London Road via the walking/cycle path.

By tram: Tramlink from Croydon or Wimbledon to Mitcham Junction station. Turn left out of station. BedZED is 15 minutes walk south down London Road (A237).

By car: Please note there is no on-site parking, though a permit may be arranged in advance if needed by activity leaders bring equipment, or people with disabilities.
